KMFFA Draft 2013

The KMFFA Draft will take place on Friday September 06 @ 0900.

New Rotations will take effect on Saturday October 05, 2013.

Rural Metro Fire Department staffing minimums (excluding St.32)

- 1. All shifts must have a minimum of one ECL. (St.10 must have two ECL's each shift)
- 2. ALS Stations must have a minimum of one Medic. Medics must choose ALS Stations. In the event of a double Medic shift, the non-Officer or least senior Medic, might be floated to fill gaps in the schedule.

 Number of available double Medic shifts will be determined by, total number of Medics at time of Draft.
- 3. There are six Floater positions. One EMT and one EMTP spot per shift. These spots are biddable.
- 4. Stations 41 and 27, Members bidding on these spots must be a minimum of Hazmat Tech or go through the next class offered. (Class T.B.D.) These Members will also be on the Special Hazards Team.
- 5. Station 10 and 31, Members bidding on these spots must be a Ladder Operator or go through the next class offered. (Class will be offered by October 05)
- 6. Each Station will have one Lieutenant. (St.41 will have two)
- 7. Each Battalion will have one Captain.

Draft Day rules of engagement

- 1. Fire Chief, His designee, or the E-Board can "freeze" the bidding process at any time, in order to maintain staffing minimums. (Selections will be limited at some point)
- 2. Station 32 Shifts will not be available for bid in this draft.
- 3. Station 10 is BLS.
- 4. Station 33 will bid ALS. (\$t.33 will not be an official "clock stopping" Station at this time. Medics in these spots might be floated to fill gaps in the schedule.)
- 5. Captains will bid first in order of seniority according to list provided by KMFFA.
- 6. Lieutenants will bid after Captains in order of seniority according to list provided by KMFFA.
- 7. Firefighters will bid after Lieutenants in order of seniority according to list provided by KMFFA.
- 8. All members will have fifteen minutes to bid after receiving notice that their turn is up. It is the responsibility of the **MEMBER** to provide accurate contact information to their Steward. Notices will be via phone call. Members unable to be notified by E-Board, will forfeit their pick and go to the bottom of the bid list. Members on Shift, who are on a call/event, will be given extra time.
- 9. For Members who know they will be unavailable on Draft Day, they must submit a written list of bidding choices. List, must be emailed to their Steward, Chief Blaylock, and Secretary Kennedy prior to the start of the Draft.
